JOICO'S GLAMOROUS, 5-MINUTE PONYTAIL IDEA



When a flight is on the horizon - and you want easy-plus-elegant in one fell swoop- Joico's got just the ticket. 01. Pull Hair Into A Low Ponytail And Create Two Sections

Brush hair back into a low ponytail, securing with thin plastic hair tie. Using your hands, smooth hair around the crown with firm hold **Power Spray** and run a drop of **Super Shine** glossing polish through the length of your ponytail. Then, create two equal sections and begin twisting one section of the ponytail away from the other.



02. Pull One Twisted Section Under And Over To The Opposite Side

Pull that twisted section under the ponytail and to the opposite side, ensuring that you keep a strong grip on the section to keep the wrap-effect tight and secure. If needed, add more **Super Shine** as you go in order to secure flyaways and add more shine.



03. Pull The Other Twisted Section In The Opposite Direction

Twist the other section of hair in the opposite direction and pull over and across so that the two sections of hair begin to make an X shape.



04. Repeat The Process, Going Back And Forth

Repeat steps two and three all the way down the shaft of the ponytail, twisting hair in opposite directions as you go.



05. Secure With A Clear Elastic And Finishing Spray

Secure the ponytail with a clear elastic a couple of inches from the bottom and spray hair all over with **Power Spray** to lock in shine and keep hair secure throughout your flight.



06. Cut Off The Top Elastic Using A Hair Pin and Scissors

For a cool, natural look and a more comfortable feel, cut the plastic hair-tie off using small scissors and a hair pin, which will help you separate the elastic from the base of the ponytail before snipping.



07. The Final Look

Voila: a goddess-worthy hairstyle that's fit for a day of travel. Pair with an effortlessly cool button-down shirt, leggings, canvas sneakers or sandals and a gorgeous oversized scarf for the perfect in-flight outfit.



You'll Need

Clear hair elastics, Joico Power Spray, Joico Super Shine, a pair of scissors, and a hair pin
